## INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

The Women's Health & Family Planning Association of Texas (WHFPT) has internships available for interested students during all semesters and quarters of the school year - including the summer. We are eager to offer bright, enthusiastic students an experience that exposes them to work with women's rights, public affairs, legislative advocacy, community education, and non-profit management.

The attached material provides all prospective student volunteers/interns with the necessary information to apply for such a position. None of these positions are paid.

It is important to us that you your internship experience is a rewarding one. Please submit your cover letter, application, and other materials in a timely fashion so we have sufficient time to make a job placement based on your interests, expertise, and future career goals. Your cover letter should describe the type of work you hope to do during your time with the agency. Upon receiving your internship application packet, someone from our office will contact you via telephone or email to schedule a personal interview.

Internships are available in specific areas. Some examples include:

- Legislative Affairs (during the legislative session)
- Public Policy Evaluation and Research
- Public Affairs and Communications
- Intergovernmental Relations
- Non-Profit Management

And some examples of specific topics are:

- Sexuality Education
- Birth Control/Emergency Contraception
- Reproductive Rights
- Teen Pregnancy
- State/National Family Planning Funding

We recommend that you send your completed materials to us no later than six to eight weeks prior to your selected starting date. There are no deadlines, however, the more time we have to review your materials, the better your chance of getting a placement in your area of interest. We look forward to hearing from you.
